Muskingum County, Before me one of the Associate Judges of the Court of Common Pleas in & for said County personally appeared Mary Anderson the daughter of Robert and Sally Horton, who was by me duly sworn according to law, do depose and say on his sacred oath that he well remembers that his father Robert Horton, was a revolutionary pensioner, and did annually receive thirty six dollars from the pension agent in the City of Richmond until the day of his death, which was on the 13th day of April 1830, that his mother Sally Horton did draw the arrearages of pension due my father from the pension agent at Richmond Virginia, that during the time that my father and mother did draw the above named pensions and arrearages they did live in Culpesper County in the State of Virginia.
